- 2. What benefits are there to having a doula during labor and delivery?
- 3. How would you handle me asking for pain medication during labor?
- 4. What kind of support can you offer me in the event of an unplanned C-section?
- 5. What is your price and cancellation/refund policy?
- 6. How many meetings and what services are included in your price?
- 7. How quickly can you get to my house or hospital once I need you?
- 8. How will I know when I need you present?
- 9. Do you have a backup who can come if you have an unexpected emergency or illness?
- 10. Will another doula relieve you if my labor goes longer than a certain number of hours and is there any additional charge for that?

- 11. What kinds of coping techniques will you help me with to manage pain and breathing during labor?
- 12. Do you have any references?
- 13. How many years of experience do you have?
- 14. How many births have you attended?
- 15. What certifications do you have?
- 16. What percent/how many of your births have been C-sections?
- 17. What percent/how many of your births have been unmedicated?
- 18. What benefits are there to having a doula if I want the epidural, have a planned C-section, etc.?
- 19. What kind of support will you offer in the event of an induction?
- 20. When will you come to the hospital if I am induced?
- 21. What kind out breastfeeding support do you offer?
- 22. How long will you stay with me after delivery?
- 23. Have you attended other births at my hospital?
- 24. Have you attended other births with my provider? Was your experience with him/her positive or negative?
- 25. How many clients do you have with due dates within a couple weeks of mine?
